**RULES:**

- Entrants must provide a minimum of 2 quarts of green chile. Remember, the more chile you provide, the more people that can taste it and potentially vote for yours for the People's Choice Award!
- Green chile with meat is defined for the purpose of this contest as any kind of meat or combination of meats cooked with green chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients.
- Meatless green chile is defined for the purpose of this contest as a combination of green chile peppers, spices and any non-meat ingredients (such as pasta, beans, tofu, etc.). If a broth base is used it must be vegetarian!
- Each entry must come with a complete ingredient list. We don't need the recipe – just the ingredients. No ingredient may be pre-cooked; exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, beans or hominy, pepper sauce, beverages, broth and spices.
- Chile must be prepared ahead of time and arrive at serving temperature on site between 10:30 and 11:00 AM. It must be brought in a roaster, crock pot, or in a large pot with your own propane camp stove. One container per entry.
- At the discretion of the judges, chile cooks may be required to taste their chile before turning it in for judging. Judges reserve the right to refuse any entry that does not meet quality standards.
- Cooks are to prepare and cook their chile in as sanitary a manner as possible.
- Judges will select the winner from each category. Prizes will be awarded as follows: Best Chile with Meat - \$200; Best Meatless Chile - \$200; People's Choice (overall) – \$200. Medals will be awarded for second and third place in each category.
- Tasting tickets will be sold to the general public. The public will vote for the recipient of the overall "People's Choice" award.
- Entrants must pick up their chile containers between 3:00 and 3:30 PM. AdWorks is not responsible for cookware that is not picked up.
